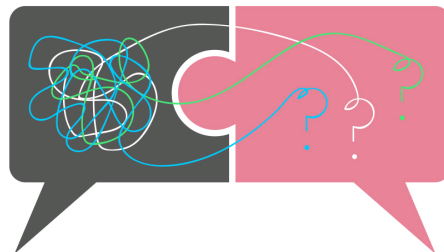
Transforming the way you lead
